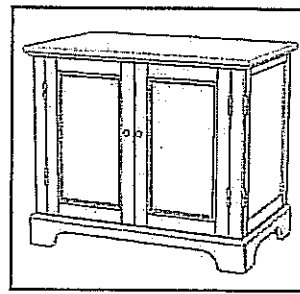

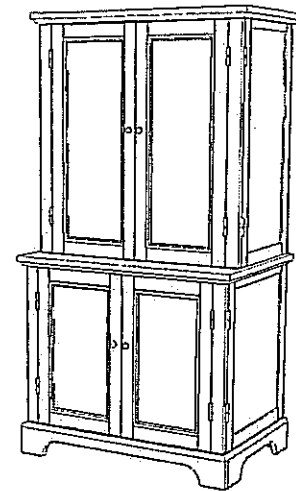

We have taken great care in the design of this product and request that you carefully and strictly follow our assembly instructions to ensure a completed product as it was designed.

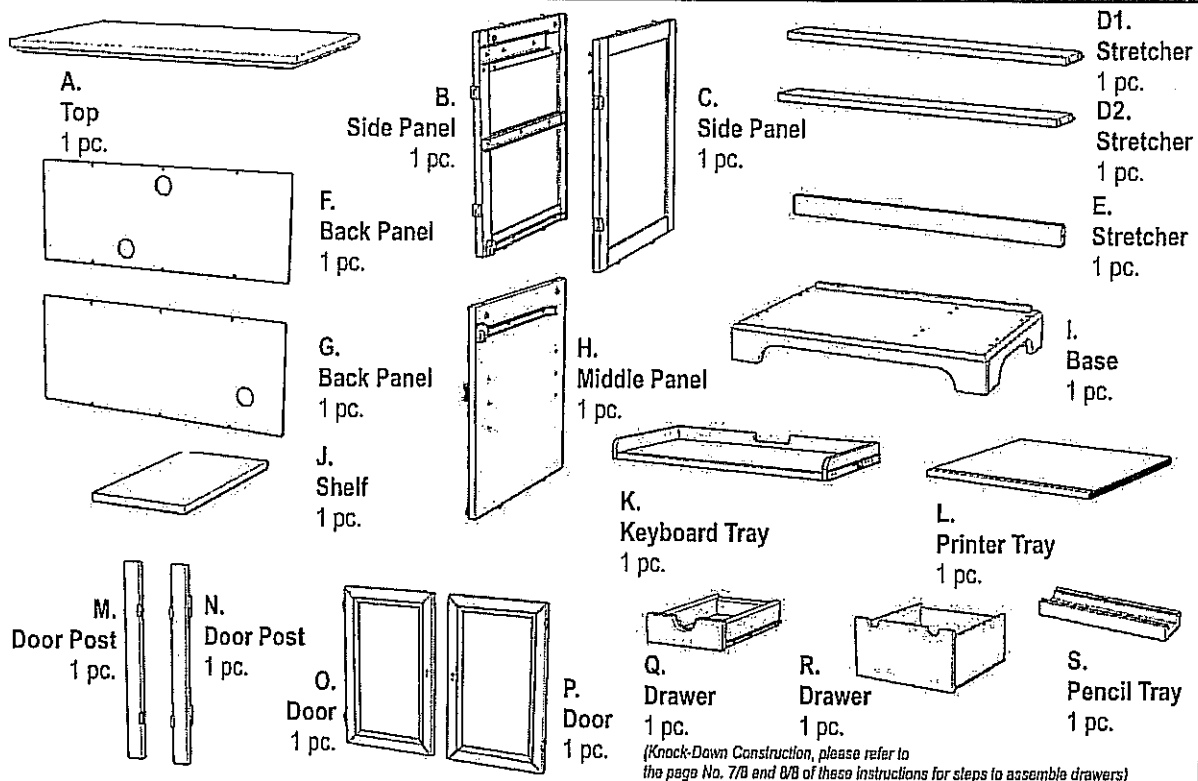

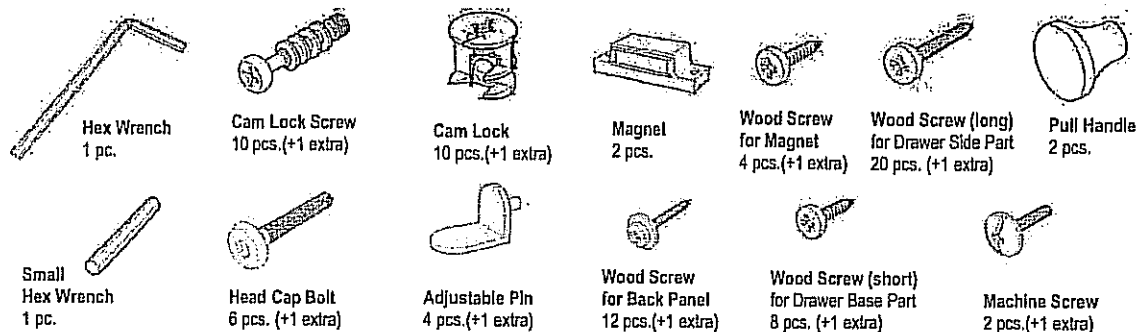

Do not tighten up all the screws until each part is properly assembled.

STEP 1

Attach 2X Magnets to pre-drilled holes of Top (A) with Wood Screws.

Insert Cam Lock Screws into the pre-drilled holes of Top (A), Side Panel (B) and (C), Stretchers (D1) and (D2).

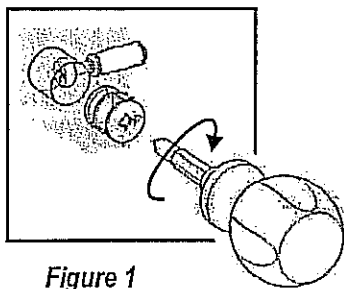
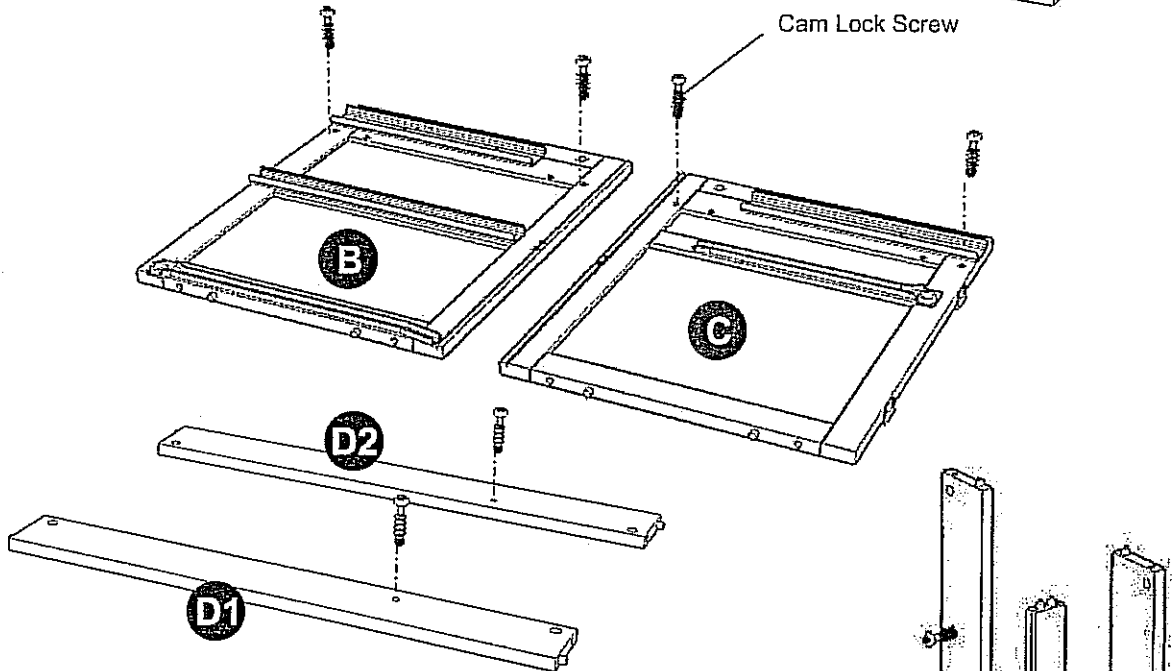
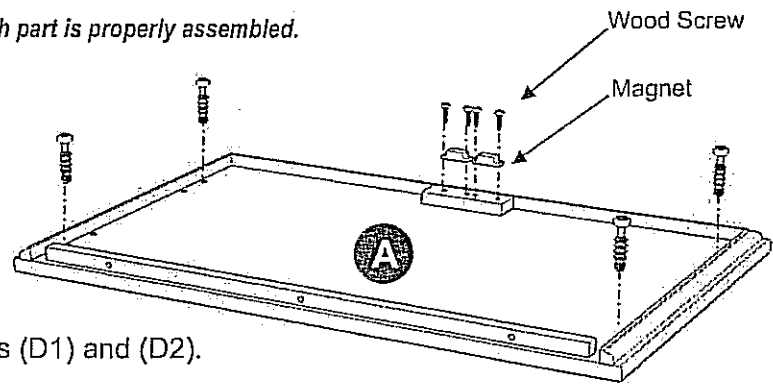
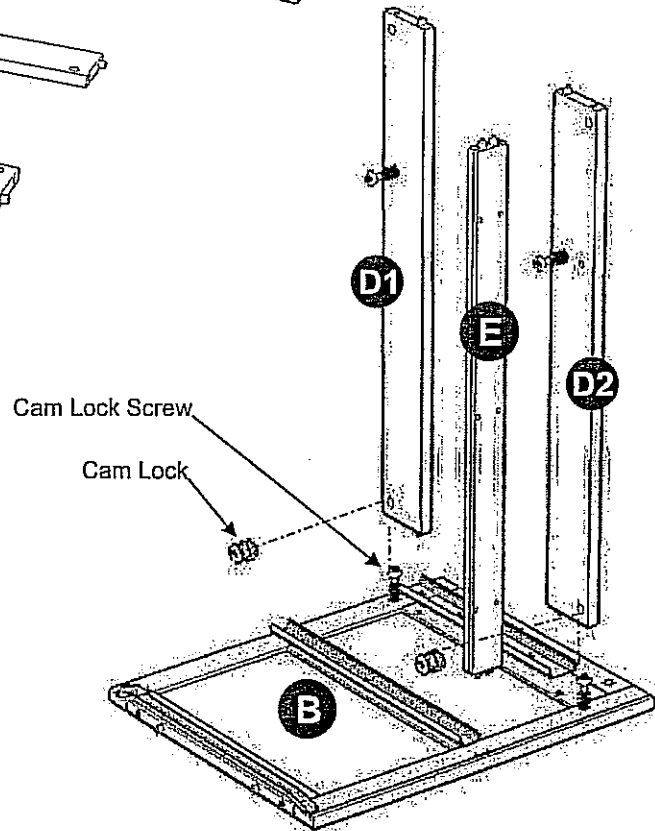

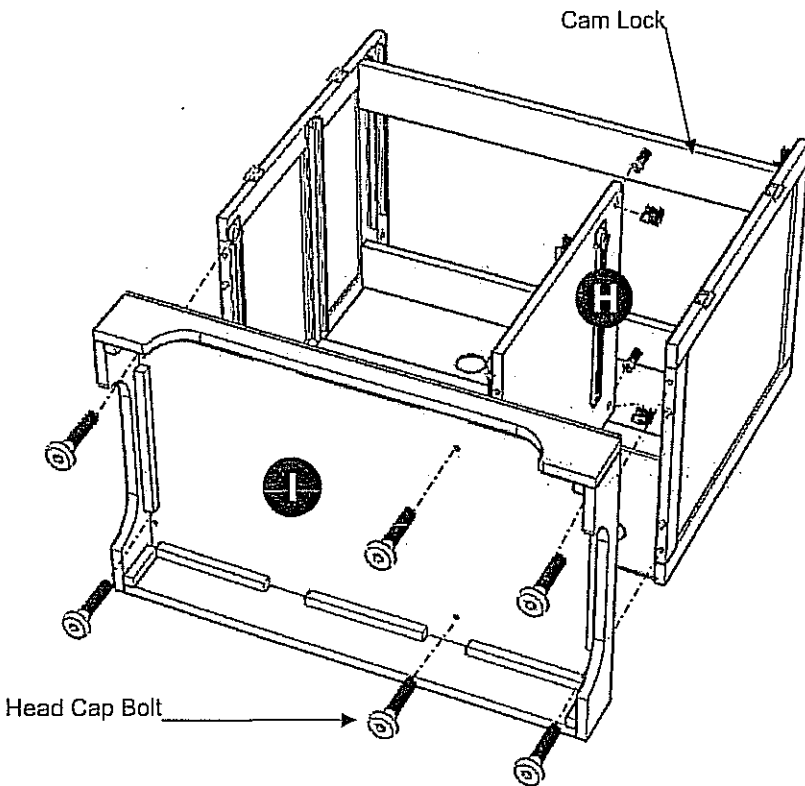
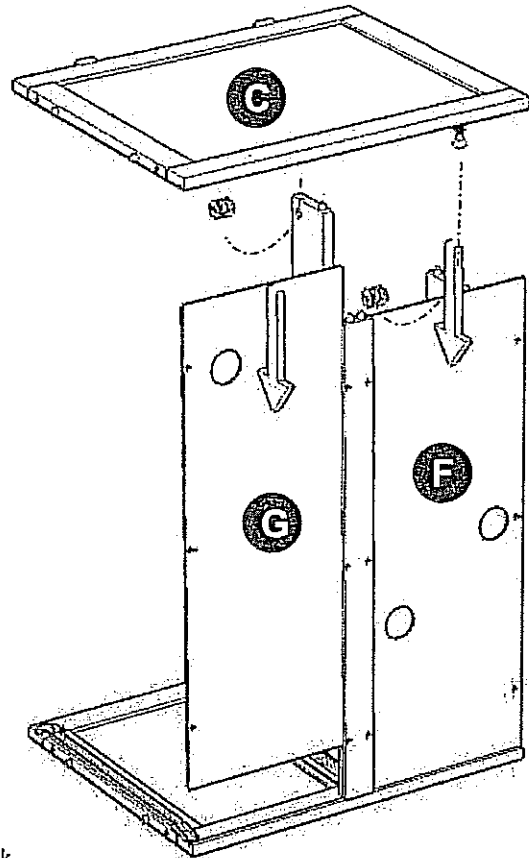
STEP 2

Attach Stretchers (D) and (E) onto Side Panel (B) with Cam Locks (see Figure 1).

STEP 3

Slide Back Panel (F) and (G) into the unit.

Attach Side Panel (C) to the unit with Cam Locks.



STEP 4

Attach Middle Panel (H) to unit with Cam Locks.

Attach Base (I) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.

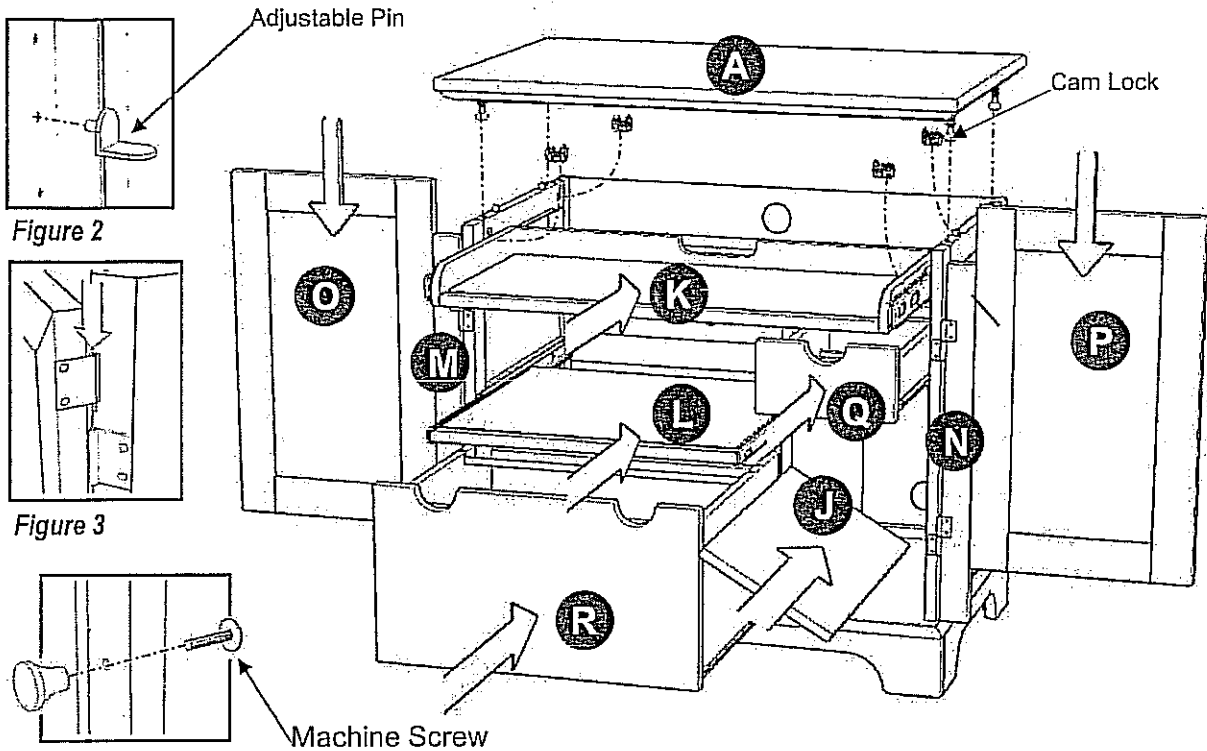

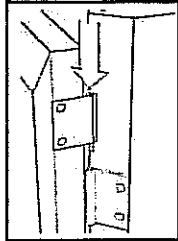

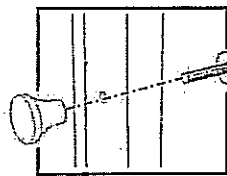

STEP 5

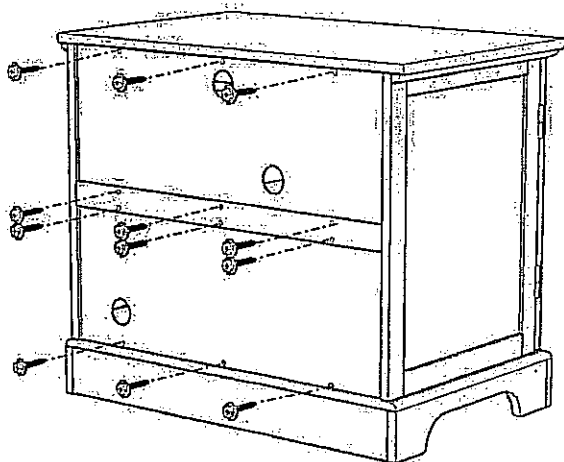
Place Top (A) onto the unit, using Cam Locks.

Slide Keyboard Tray (K), Printer Tray (L), Drawer (Q) and (R) into position.

Insert Adjustable Pins into side panel and middle panel at the desired level (See figure 2), then place Shelf (J) into position.

Attach Door Post (M), (N), Doors (O) and (P) by sliding the door lift hinges into the side panels lift hinges (See figure 3).

Assemble Pull Handles to Doors (O) and (P) with Machine Screws. (See figure 4)

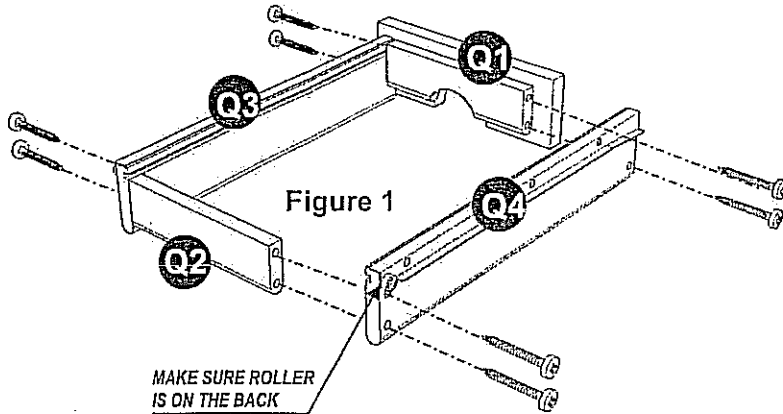
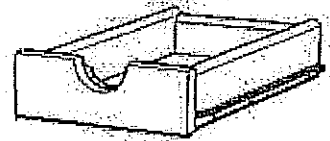


STEP 6

Insert 12X Wood Screws from the back of the unit, tighten up all the Wood Screws.

Note: Please make sure unit is level before tightening these screws.

Drawer (Q)



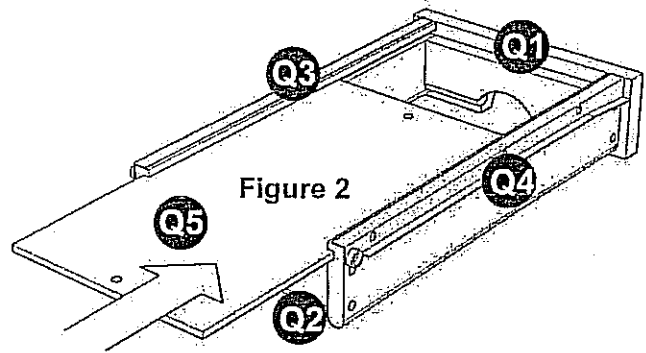
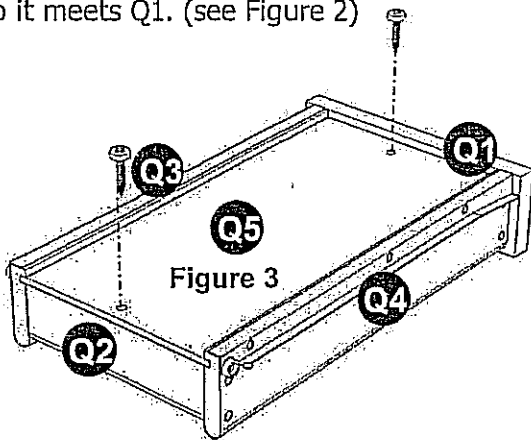
STEP 1

Attach Q1 to Q3 and Q4, using a Phillips screw driver and long wood screws (4X), tighten halfway.

Attach Q2 to Q3 and Q4 using long wood screws (4X), tighten halfway. (see Figure 1)

STEP 2

Slide Q5 into the grooves in Q3 and Q4. Be sure to push Q5 all the way forward so it meets Q1. (see Figure 2)

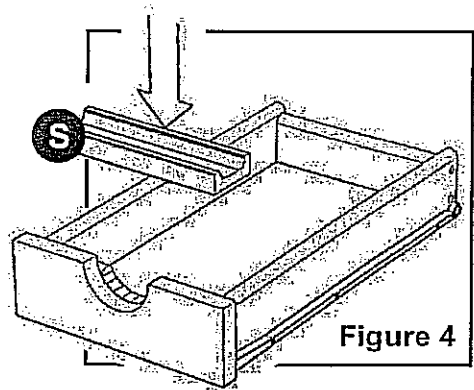


STEP 3

Insert short wood screws (2X) into the pre-drilled holes in Q5, tighten screws. (see Figure 3)

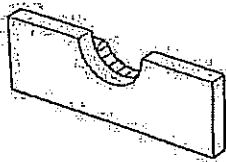
STEP 4

Place Pencil Tray (S) into the position. (see Figure 4)

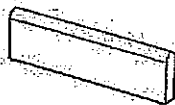


Tighten all screws used in drawer assembly.

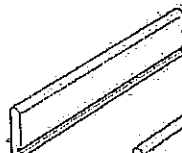

STEP 1

Attach R1 to R3 and R4, using a Phillips screw driver and long wood screws (6X), tighten halfway.

Attach R2 to R3 and R4 using long wood screws (6X), tighten halfway. (see Figure 1)

STEP 2

Slide R5 into the grooves in R3 and R4. Be sure to push R5 all the way forward so it meets R1. (see Figure 2)

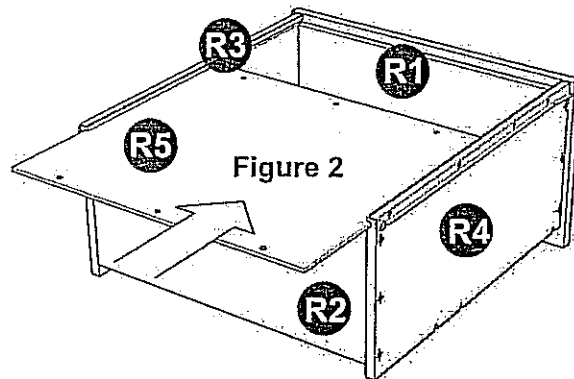

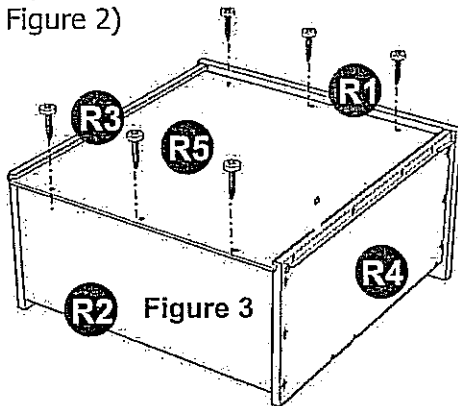

STEP 3

Insert short wood screws (6X) into the pre-drilled holes in R5, tighten screws. (see Figure 3)

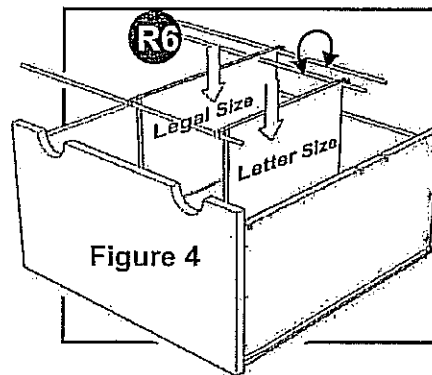

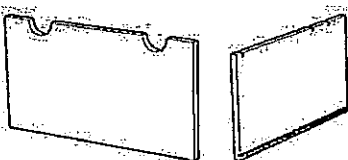
STEP 4

You can adjust the Metal Strip for letter size or legal size file as shown.

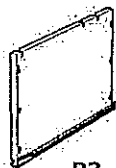
Tighten all screws used in drawer assembly.

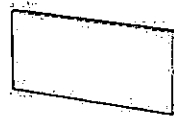

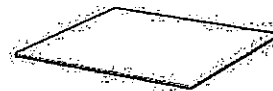

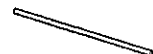
